### Program Description

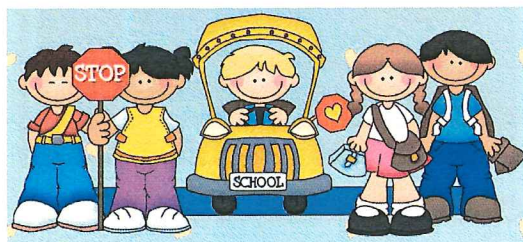
We are serving students aged 3-5 in a 3 class design to meet the developmental needs of each level.

**3 year old Class:** Students must be 3 by August 1, 2019 and will enroll in the 4 year old class the next year. They will meet M,-Th from 9:15-11:30. Maximum capacity = 12; teacher/student ratio 1:6.

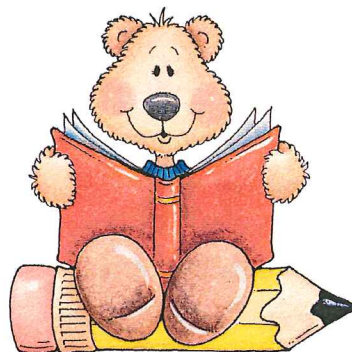
**4 year old Class:** Students must be 4 after August 1, 2019 and will enroll in the K Prep class the next year. They will meet M-Th from 12:45-3:00. Maximum capacity = 22; teacher/student ratio 1:11.

**Kindergarten Prep Class:** Students must be 4 by August 1, 2019 and will enroll in Grade K the next year. We will meet 4 days, M-Th from 9:15-3:00. Maximum capacity = 22; teacher/student ratio 1:11.

\*All students must be potty trained and must live in the Orrville City Schools district.



- **K Prep parent meeting and orientation**  
Thursday, August 22, 2019 5:00 pm with Open House following from 5:30-6:00 pm
- **4 year and 3 year old classes parent meeting and orientation** Thursday, August 22, 2019 6:00 pm with Open House following from 6:30-7:00 pm
- 1st student day for classes will be the of August 26, 2019.
- After 1st day, calendar follows Orrville City Schools (excluding Fridays). The last day is May 21, 2019 for all programs.
- Monthly fees (income-based rate between \$5-75) are due no later than the 25th of each month, or can be paid semi-annually/annually. All fees will be accepted at OES, made payable to OES.
