Early Learning Programs

Complete application required

- Available March 2, 2021 at Orrville Elementary and Orrville Board of Education offices or online
- Due June 4, 2021 to OES or BOE office
- Enrollment notification no later than June 29, 2021

Program Description

We are serving students aged 4-5 in a 2 class design to meet the developmental needs of each level.

4 year old Class: Students must be 4 after August 1, 2021 and will enroll in the K Prep class the next year. They will meet M-Th from 8:50-11:20 am. Maximum capacity = 22; teacher/student ratio 1:11.

Kindergarten Prep Class: Students must be 4 by August 1, 2021 and will enroll in Grade K the next year. We will meet 4 days, M-Th from 12:30-3:00 pm. Maximum capacity = 22; teacher/student ratio 1:11.

*All students must be potty trained and must live in the Orrville City Schools district.



- 1st student day for classes will be August 23, 2021
- After 1st day, calendar follows Orrville City Schools (excluding Fridays). The last day is May 19, 2022 for all programs.
- Monthly fees (income-based rate between \$5-75) are due no later than the 25th of each month, or can be paid semi-annually/annually. All fees will be accepted at OES, made payable to OES.
- Arrival and dismissal for parent transport will be at the Main Office of OES, Door #1. Parents are asked to park in the parking lot and walk to the door when dropping off or picking up students.
