Dear Senior or Junior,

Orrville High School's Prom will be May 4, 2024 at the White Oak Event Center, formerly The Pines. Here is some important information relating to the event:

**The theme is Golden Gala.**

1. 5:00–Grand March line up and pictures with Marty's Studio
2. 5:30–Grand March in OHS auditorium
3. 6:00-6:15–arrival at the White Oak Event Center
4. 6:30-7:30–**Dinner will be served.**
5. 7:30-10:00–Prom at the White Oak

Prom promises to be a fun evening, but please remember these guidelines to ensure that you have the best time possible:

1. All those attending must be a senior or junior.
2. A senior or junior may invite a freshman or sophomore to prom provided that **a)** the underclassman has the enclosed permission slip signed by a parent, and **b)** they are an OHS student. **UNDERCLASSMEN FROM OTHER SCHOOLS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**
3. You may invite a junior or senior from another high school, provided that the enclosed permission slip is filled out by the administration of their school. Your guest must have ID to be admitted to prom. If your guest has already graduated, please only Orrville alumni.
4. No one 21 or over will be allowed in.
5. This is a school sponsored function. All rules and policies will apply in order to maintain a safe and healthy environment. Additionally, to ensure the safety of all attendees, local law enforcement will be on premises.
6. **STUDENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES, UNLESS PICKED UP BY A PARENT.**

Prom tickets will go on sale **April 9, 2024**, before school the office, during lunch, and after school in Mrs. Besancon's room. Last day of sales will be April 26, 2024. There will be a change this year, which is that dinner will again be served at Prom. For that reason, ticket prices will increase to \$45/person, or \$80/couple. This removes the significant gap in time after Grand March, and will make the evening more safe and enjoyable. Students will sit at tables of 10, so please have your group organized prior to buying tickets.

After Prom will be at Massillon Rec Center following Prom. All are invited to attend. Games and prizes will be given out. More information will follow.
